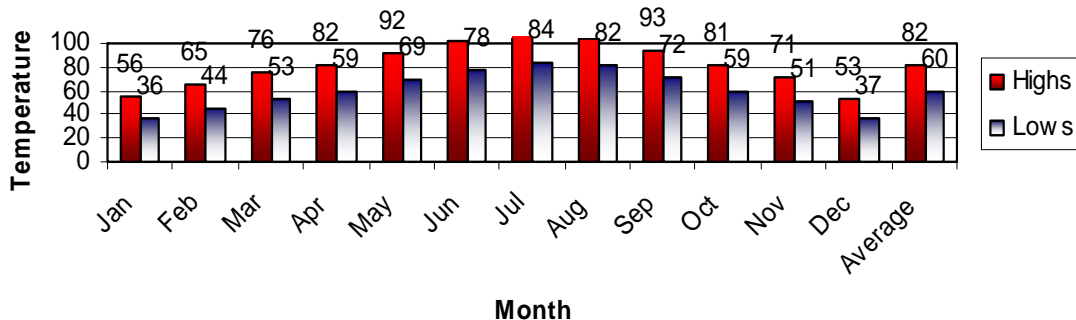
Climate

Las Vegas climate is classified as arid (dry). It averages 294 days of Sunshine per year (211 clear days, 83 partly cloudy). Highs of 105° are common from May to September, with several days exceeding 115°. The average annual rainfall is 4.13 inches. Humidity stays around 29%.

Problems: Because Las Vegas is in a valley, if heavy rainfall occurs, flooding may be the result. The mountains surrounding the valley can also act as a trap for smog and other pollutants.



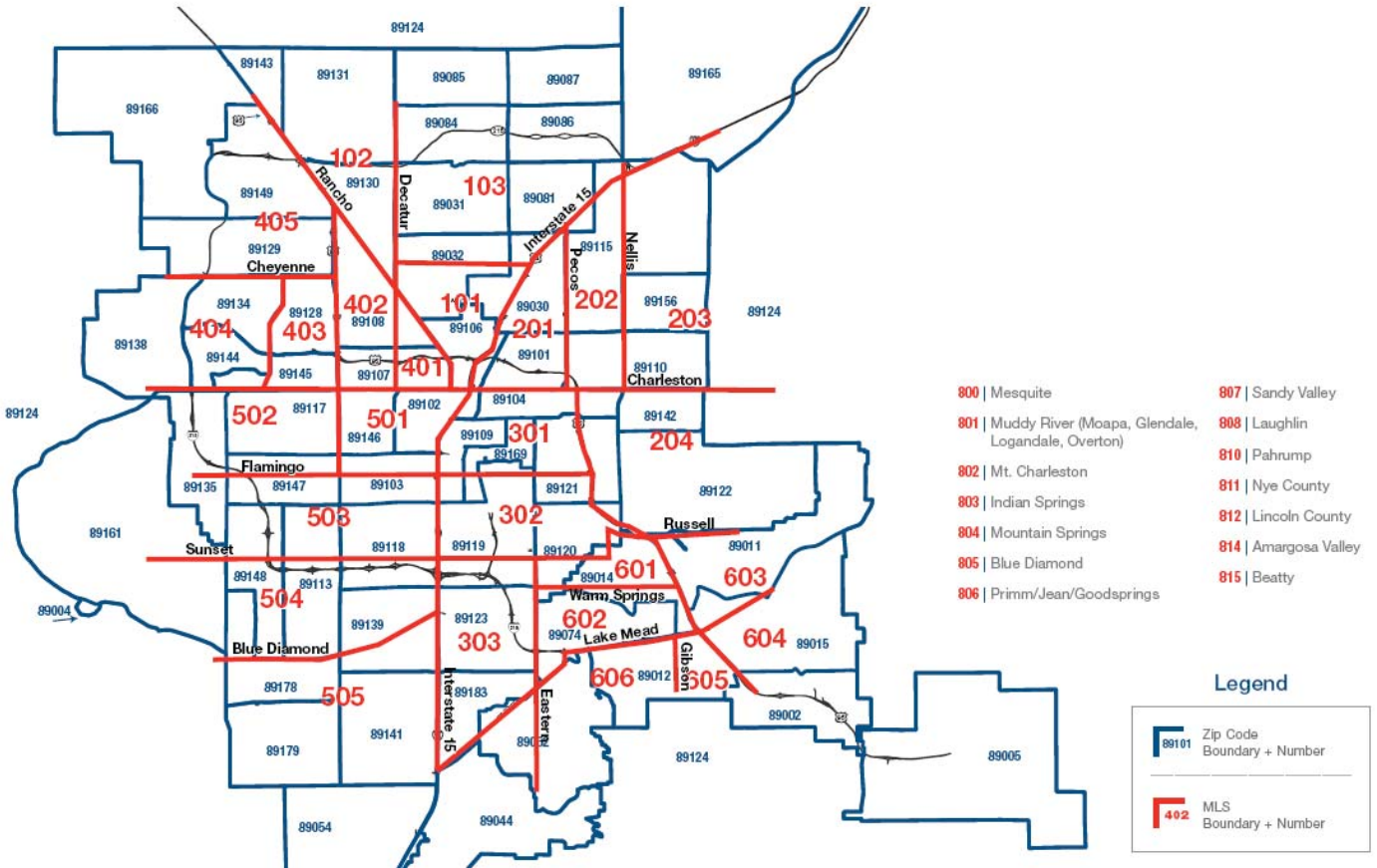
Las Vegas Temperatures

Registering your vehicle:

Students and active duty personnel (including dependents) do not need to register their vehicles or acquire a new license in Nevada as long as the individual is not employed in the State of Nevada. Vehicles must be currently registered with the home state of valid insurance and driver's license.

Out-of-state drivers and vehicle registrations can be used by new residences for up to 30 days or before the prior items expire, whichever comes first. At any time during that 30 days, they may be turned in to the DMV for Nevada documents.

Nevada law requires motorists to notify DMV of a change of address within 30 days of the move. Keeping your address current is important so they can send renewal notices in the mail.



New Nevada Vehicle Registration:

Documents needed to register are the ORIGINALS of:

- Most recent registration
- Out of State Plates
- Nevada emissions Vehicle Inspection report (smog check) if needed
- Nevada Proof of Insurance
- Nevada Vehicle inspection certificate (VIN Check)
- Certificate of Title if ownership is changing. If not changing ownership, the owner has the option of retaining the out-of-state title.

Nevada is a closed primary state, which means voters cannot vote for partisan offices in the primary election unless they are either registered with the Democratic or Republican parties.

To register to vote in Clark County, applicants must be a U. S. citizen, 18 years old by the election date and have lived in the state and county for at least 30 days and within their precinct 10 days prior to the election.

To receive an application by mail, call, write, or fax a request to the Clark County Election Department at 455-VOTE. Mail-in applications are available at the LVCC and all libraries and post offices. You may also register to vote at the Clark County Election Dept. or any of the Department of Motor Vehicles Offices.

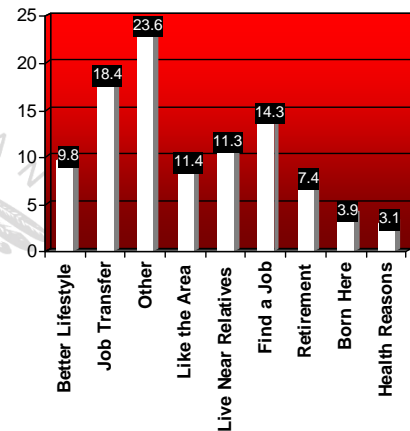

Health Card

Health Cards are mandatory for all food/beverage handlers, tattoo technicians, Security Officer, child and adult care attendants, Health Club Attendant or massage therapists.

In order to acquire a Health Card, you must complete an application form. For a food handler card, applicants will receive a Hepatitis A vaccination. Applicants needing a Child Care or Adult Care Card, will also receive a Hepatitis A vaccination as well as having a skin test or x-ray for tuberculosis. All applicants must also attend an hour and a half class and movie within 30 days of applying for a Health Card. A temporary card will be issued until the class is completed. The cost for a Health Card is \$35 for a three year issuance. For additional information, contact:

TRANSPORTATION

Las Vegas is a hub for airlines, railroads, trucking and highways. Major and regional airlines find Las Vegas to be one of their most popular destinations. Las Vegas was founded as a railroad city. Because of its central location, it is still a principal on-route destination for the railroads.

Las Vegas' convention and entertainment industries, together with unparalleled outdoor recreation, have stimulated phenomenal growth in Southern Nevada. Today, nearly half of all Las Vegas visitors arrive by air via McCarran International Airport, making it a major driving force in the Southern Nevada economy and one of the top ten busiest airports in the world. Income derived from aviation activity generates significant economic benefits estimated at 25 billion dollars a year. In addition to these tangible benefits, McCarran is a valuable community asset that links Southern Nevada to the national air transportation system and brings the world to Las Vegas.

Private aviation is serviced at McCarran, the North Las Vegas Air Terminal and Sky Harbor Airport in Henderson. Limousine and taxi service is available 24 hours.

Citizens Area Transit has been serving Las Vegas since December 1992. CAT ridership increased from 15 million in 1993 to more than 63 million in 2007. The RTC introduced The Deuce, a premiere double decker transportation service, to the Las Vegas Strip on Oct. 27, 2005. It services the residential routes of Las Vegas and Henderson in addition to the "Strip." In 2009 the RTC will launch the ACE Rapid Transit system starting with the ACE Downtown Connector.

The system consists of 36 routes served by 360 vehicles, carrying close to 190,000 passengers everyday in the greater Las Vegas Valley.

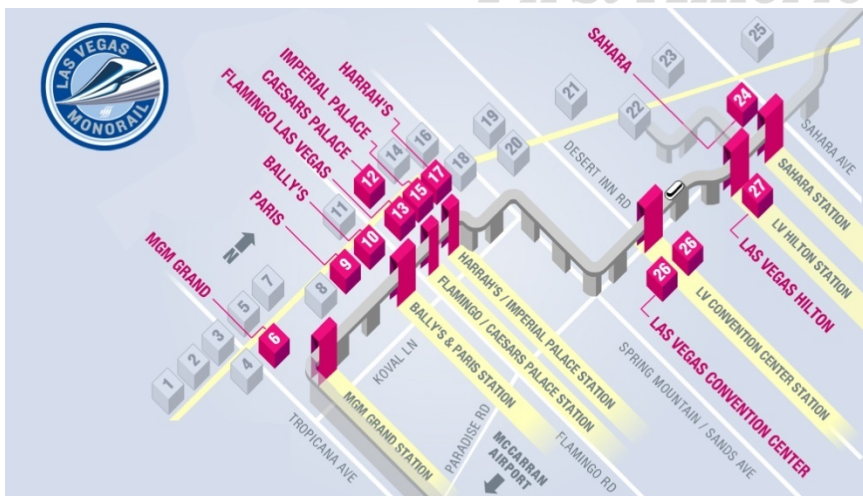

Taxes

Las Vegas has NO PERSONAL INCOME TAX. There is no state income, inheritance, gift or estate taxes.

Inventory or corporate taxes are levied. The low overall taxes has made Las Vegas a hot-spot for industrial and professional growth.

The Clark County Assessor's Office determines the taxable value of each parcel of land – improved or unimproved. This value is multiplied by 35% to acquire the assessed value of the property.

Property taxes are figured by multiplying the assessed value by the tax rate – which is limited to a total of \$3.64 per \$100 assessed.

Property Tax Due Dates

Payments are made quarterly and as follows:

1st Quarter: 3rd Monday of August

2nd Quarter: 1st Monday of October

3rd Quarter: 1st Monday of January

4th Quarter: 1st Monday of March

Master Planned Communities

Aliante

This is the flagship master-planned development of North Las Vegas. It has 1,165 acres to be dedicated to residential and 100 acres for commercial development. Amenities include an 18-hole championship golf course, parks, and a 24-mile trail system.

Anthem

An upscale development by Del Webb, Anthem is located high in the hills of the McCullough mountains, 2,525 acres, with spectacular views of the Las Vegas Valley. Developments within the Anthem master plan include Anthem Highlands, Anthem Country Club and Coventry at Anthem.

Green Valley Ranch

Nestled in the foothills of the Black Mountains and masterfully designed on 1,311 acres, this community is peaceful and clean, with easy access to I-215. The area is in close proximity to The District at Green Valley Ranch and the Henderson Multigenerational Center.

Inspirada

Iron Mountain Ranch

Lake Las Vegas

MacDonald Highlands

Mountains Edge

A 3,500 acre community that when full developed, will offer 4 elementary schools, 2 middle schools, a high school, a fire station, shopping centers and restaurants, with more that 500 acres designated for parks and trails. Nevada Trails

Providence

Queensridge

Set against the back drop of Red Rock Canyon on the west side of Las Vegas this community is surrounded by the Badlands Golf Course. Community features include: spa, swimming pools, tennis courts, child play area, exercise facilities, and an exclusive club & fitness center.

Red Rock Country Club

Red Rock composes 735-acres of exclusive and personalized homes and features two 18-hole golf courses designed by Arnold Palmer. Red Rock Country Club covers 42,000 square feet, and borders the Red Rock Canyon National Conservation Area, providing panoramic views of the Las Vegas valley. The clubhouse features recreational and social pursuits, including an aquatic center, fitness facility and tennis center.

Rhodes Ranch

In Southwest Las Vegas, Rhodes Ranch is the picturesque beauty of a waterfall and tropical palms, the peace of mind of a guarded entrance and the flair of a championship links-style golf course.

Seven Hills

Located in the Southeast of the valley in Henderson, A 1,300 acre community high above the city offering 2500 homes surrounded by business parks and shopping, there are golf course homes, a 27 hole golf course, clubhouse, tennis and a 2,000 seat stadium.

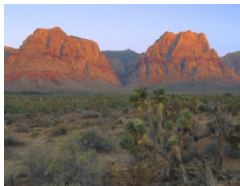

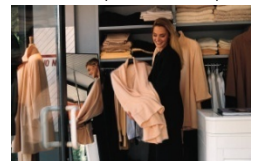
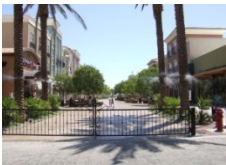

Clark County School District (CCSD) is the fifth largest in the United States with 311,240 students for the 2008-2009 enrollment. It operates one of the nation's largest school construction and modernization programs. Approximately \$4.9 billion will be spent to build new schools and improve existing schools.

The district operates 347 schools as of the 2008-2009 school year which consists of 210 elementary schools; 59 middle schools; 45 high schools; 25 alternative schools; and 8 special schools. The district employs 38,611 people, including about 18,168 teachers as well as part-time, substitute and temporary employees.

CCSD offers a range of programs for the special needs of their students. In addition to core curriculum, CCSD offers magnet schools and programs, various accelerated and Advance Placement programs and special education services.

Accountability Reports

Accountability Reports furnished each spring to parents include statistics about a school's performance as well as achievements, highlights, awards, goals and technology use. Accountability Reports are available online from the Clark County School District's web site at www.ccsd.net on the "Schools" link then on School Accountability Reports.

Age Requirements

Nevada law requires school attendance between ages 7 and 18. Kindergarten is part of the regular school program. A child must be five years old on or before September 30 to attend kindergarten and must be six years old on or before September 30 to enter first grade. State law requires that a child must attend a state-approved kindergarten program or take a developmental assessment test to enter first grade.

Bus Services

Students who live more than 2 miles from zoned schools are eligible for bus transportation. Those who are eligible must fill out an application form requesting the service. The forms are available throughout the Clark County School District. Bus times and route schedules can be obtained through your child's school or at www.ccsd.net/transportation.

Students with zone variances will NOT be bused. Parents will be responsible for the child's transportation to and from school.

Meals at School

All schools give students the opportunity to purchase breakfast and hot lunches.

Elementary schools average \$.80 for breakfast and \$1.40 for lunches.

Middle Schools average \$1.00 for breakfast and \$1.60-\$2.50 for hot lunches.

High Schools average \$1.50 for breakfast and \$3.00 for lunch. Many a la carte offerings also are available.

For students in kindergarten through the 8th grade, applications for free or reduced-price meals can be found at the school's office or cafeteria.

SKILLS

Enrollment

In order to enroll students:

- Must have proof of immunizations before classes begin
- Parents entering their children in a District School for the first time must have identification, child's social security number, and two forms of proof of address. Proof of child's identity can be the original birth certificate or passport. Identification must be an original – no copies are accepted. The required proof of address can be a recent utility bill, rent receipt, residence lease or sales contract. Telephone bills, cable bills, and driver's license are not accepted as proof of address.
- All students who are transferring from another school district require transcripts or report cards from the previous school.

Immunizations

Nevada law requires that children in kindergarten through grade 12 are current with their immunizations **before** they are allowed to enter school. Parents/guardians are to bring immunization records with them to school when they register their child.

A child **will not** be allowed to attend school without documentation of immunizations. Exceptions are permitted for "religious objections," which requires a letter from the parent or guardian stating the religious objection, or for a medical condition, which requires a letter from a health care provider.

For the new school year, students must be up to date with all required immunizations. Students entering 7th grade also must have the recently-mandated Tdap vaccine which protects against tetanus, diphtheria and pertussis, or whooping cough.

Students new to Nevada are required to have immunizations for hepatitis A and B, and varicella (chicken pox). If a child has had chicken pox, the parent or guardian must sign a "Verification of Disease" form, which is available at each school. A second dose of MMR is required for **all** kindergarten and first-grade students.

High School Graduation Requirements

To graduate from the CCSD, students must complete their required course work and pass the Nevada High School Proficiency Exams in reading, writing and math. (A science exam will be added for the class of 2010). Students who enter ninth grade must earn 22 ½ credits in the following subjects:

- English – 4 credits
- Math – 3 credits*
- Science – 2 credits
- U.S. History – 1 credit
- U.S. Government – 1 credit
- Physical Education – 2 Credits**
- World History – 1 credit***
- Health Education – ½ credit
- Computers – ½ credit
- Electives – 7 ½ credits

*Starting with the class of 2007, math course units must include at least Algebra 1 or 1H, or Applied Algebra 1A or 1B, or above.

**A maximum of one PE II unit can be earned by participation in certain activities.

***World history satisfies the state Art/Humanities requirement.

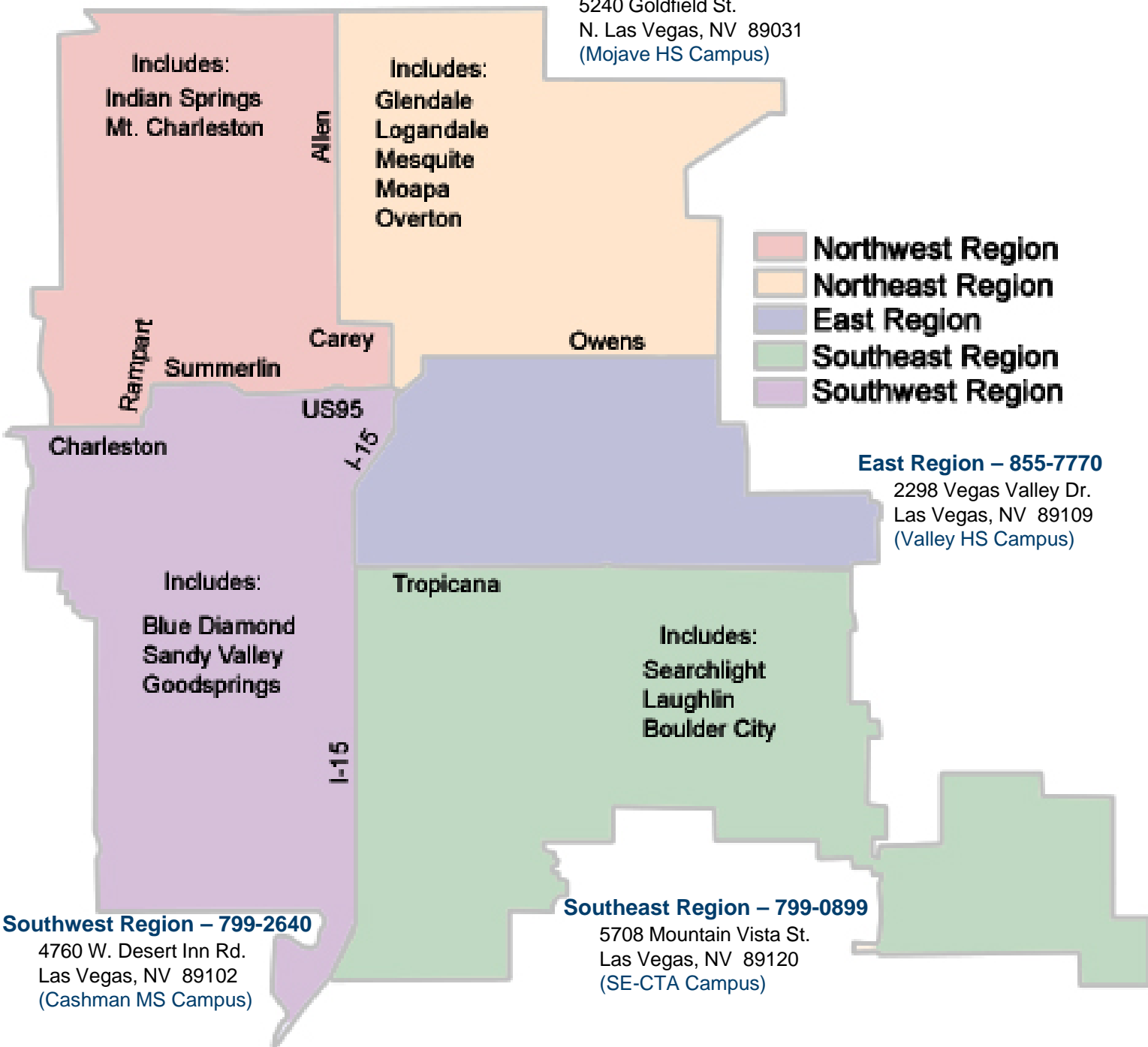
